What goes in the blue bin?



- Waste and packaging made of paper, cardboard, and paperboard
- The blue bin is emptied every four weeks
- Break down bulky cardboard boxes to save space
- We do not collect cardboard boxes left next to the bin
- Free drop-off at recycling centers

What goes in the yellow bin?



- Empty packaging made of plastic, metal, and composite materials
- The yellow bin is emptied every two weeks
- Aluminum lids from plastic...
- Do not nest packages inside one another

What goes in the brown bin?



- All organic kitchen and garden waste
- The brown bin is emptied weekly from June through October; otherwise, every two weeks
- Place moist organic waste in paper bags, newspaper, or paper towels
- Do not put plastic bags in the organic waste bin—not even “compostable” ones!

What goes in the gray bin?



- Non-hazardous waste that does not belong in the blue, brown, or yellow bins
- The gray bin is emptied every two weeks
- Paper, food waste, packaging, electronic devices, and hazardous materials do not belong in the general waste bin
